

## STEM

Using green yarn,

**Round 1:** 5 sc in magic ring (5 sts)

**R2:** 2 sc in each st around. (10 sts)

**R3:** Sc 10 in each round until the stem measures 4.5 inches long.

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

## BACK CIRCLE

(Goes on top of the stem, on the back of the flower)

Using green yarn,

**Round 1:** 6 sc in magic ring (6 sts)

**R2:** 2 sc in each st around. (12 sts)

**R3:** \*Sc 1, 2 sc in next st,\* 6 times. (18 sts)

**R4:** \*Sc 2, 2 sc in next st,\* 6 times. (24 sts)

**R5:** Sc 24.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## LEAF: MAKE 2

Using green yarn,

**Round 1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** Sc 6.

**R3:** 2 sc in each st around. (12 sts)

**R4:** \*Sc 1, 2 sc in next st,\* 6 times. (18 sts)

**R5-6:** Sc 18.

**R7:** \*Sc 1, inv dec 1,\* 6 times. (12 sts)

**R8-10:** Sc 12.

**R11:** Inv dec around 6 times. (6 sts)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

## TO MAKE A DAISY

You will need white yarn for the petals and yellow yarn for the center. Crochet all the same pieces as you would for the sunflower, replacing the petals with the pattern below.

## PETALS: MAKE 9

Using white yarn,

**Round 1:** 6 sc in magic ring (6 sts)

**R2:** 2 sc in each st around. (12 sts)

**R3-5:** Sc 12.

**R6:** \*Sc 1, inv dec 1,\* 4 times. (8 sts)

**R7:** Sc 8.

**R8:** \*Sc 1, inv dec 1,\* 2 times, sc 1 and sl st into the last st. (5 sts)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

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
